Army Recruiting Transformation Initiatives

Secretary of the Army Christine Wormuth and Chief of Staff of the Army Randy George detailed sweeping changes in how the Army will identify and recruit talent - from expanding its focus to a larger share of the youth labor market and creating a specialized talent acquisition workforce to initiating an experimentation and learning capability.

Five Key Areas Outlined:

Transform how the Army prospects

Transform the Army's recruiting workforce

Create an experimentation capability within USAREC

Enhance the evidence base for recruiting policy decisions

Aligning Army recruiting leadership and structure

Recent Recruiting Quotes from Army Senior Leaders

"Right now, 83% of the young men and women coming into the Army are coming from military families," he said. "However, only 23% of Americans are qualified to serve. We are not going to lower standards. Quality is more important than quantity." Gen. James McConville, Former Chief of Staff of the Army.

"Recruiting is one of the most important missions in the Army, and these changes reflect that importance," added Randy George., Army Chief of Staff. Both Wormuth and George said the Army also needs to better convey to young Americans the value of service and the opportunities the Army presents.

"This is a big, total-team effort, and we will succeed at this," TRADOC Commanding General Gary Brito said. "But, in order to deliver that Army of 2030 and get ready for 2040, we will continue to be innovative in our talent management approaches, and we will turn this recruiting challenge into an opportunity."
