MS. HEINEMEYER: I believe since you have 1 filed this petition, the 1998 Muscogee County 2 conviction was vacated and so right now you are 3 awaiting a new trial on the 1998 conviction and 4 back in the fall you were re-released on parole, 5 they had a final parole revocation hearing at which 6 time they revoked you for violating your parole by 7 committing these charges; is that correct? 8 That's what it seems like MR. WELDON: 9 but what I'm trying to say, I've been prejudiced by 10 them releasing me and re-arresting me on these same 11 charges because they gave me an immediate release. 12 My brother told me the Parole Board said since it 13 took two years, they were supposed to took me back 14 to court, my case got overturned in 2000, December 15 of 2000, and they were supposed to take me back to 16 court right then and they never did do it. 17 What kind of charge was THE COURT: 18 that? 19 Sale of cocaine. And MR. WELDON: 20 they gave me sale of cocaine and resisting ---21 THE COURT: They gave you a new 22 23 trial? MR. WELDON: They were supposed to 24 have had, but like I say ---25
