

I believe that love is the greatest thing in the world; that it alone can overcome hate; that right can will triumph over might.John D. Rockefeller, Jr.

Although John D. Rockefeller Jr. spent most of his life engaged in philanthropy, his single, defining business venture was the creation of a "city within a city."

Constructed during the Great Depression's worst years, the project gainfully employed over 40,000 people. When Rockefeller Center officially opened in May, 1933, it held true to the developing team's belief that art was an act of good citizenship.
