





Atlas is a seven ton bronze sculpture which sits at the Fifth Avenue entrance to the Rockefeller Centre.

Lee Lawrie (1877-1963) born in Rixdorf, Germany conceived and designed the figure whilst Rene Chambellan modeled the heroic Titan from Greek Mythology.

It was installed in 1937 and Atlas is 15 feet tall standing on a 9 foot granite pedestal. The entire sculpture is 45 feet tall and impressive from every angle.
