

This coming Lord's Day, May 10, we plan to begin gathered Worship inside the Sanctuary with some major modifications. Please be patience and understanding as we continue to keep your health a priority.

- **Options for Worship:** Do not attend if you are sick or uncomfortable coming inside the building. This is a very personal decision especially if you are at a higher risk, and we understand completely. You can Worship via Facebook Live from home or while seated in your car in the parking lot. In addition, we will post the service to YouTube later in the day.
- **Meet and Greet:** Plan to meet and greet outside before and after the service while maintaining at least 6' of space between each other. As hard as it is, make an effort to avoid close talking, hugging and shaking hands.
- **Nursery:** The nursery will be open and available to parents to care for their own children as needed.
- **Use the front doors to enter/exit the church** and avoid the habit of using the kitchen as a foyer.
- **Seating:** We doubled the space between rows in the sanctuary. Please sit with your family and allow at least 2 empty chairs between you and anyone else that you are not currently quarantined with at home. To extend seating, all 4 classrooms and the Pastor's office will be open for families or individuals spaced at least 6' apart.
- **Outside Seating:** Weather permitting, we will provide seating outside under the portico for approximately 20 chairs. The front doors will be open during the service to allow for additional airflow into the building and so those seated outside can hear the service.
- **Bulletins:** The bulletin will not be distributed. Please print a PDF copy before you leave home if you want a printed copy.
- **Coffee:** You are welcome to bring your own coffee, tea or water to church; we do not plan to prepare or serve coffee or snacks at this time.
- **Face Masks:** You are welcome to wear a face mask, which is proven to slow the spread of germs from you to others and provides some protection for yourself as well.
- **Offering:** Offering plates and baskets for the deacon's fund contributions will be on the table at the back of the church. You may also continue to mail your offering to the church address or contribute online if that is more convenient.

• Continue to Minister to One Another During the Week: PLEASE continue to pray for one another and continue to be calling and texting each other. You guys have been great about this!

We are very excited for May 10<sup>th</sup> and look forward to a great day of worship together.
