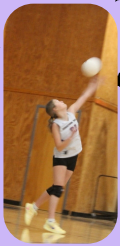

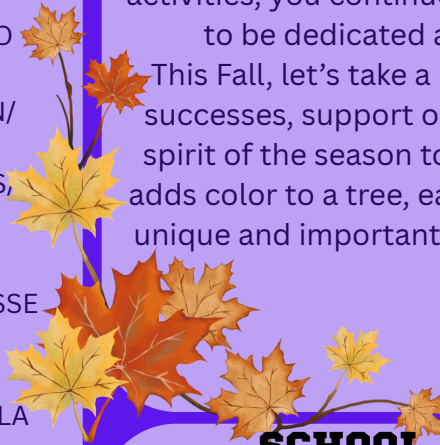
Hello Fall!

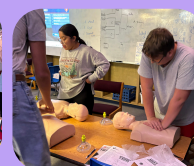
