Masks: Upon further examination of the ND Mask Mandate, it appears all children age 5 and up need to be wearing a mask, even in our school group with 15 or less people in the room. We apologize for not realizing this sooner. Preschools and child care providers received the following information on December 23rd: "The state mask mandate states children that are 5 years or older need to wear a mask. Do I need to require a 5-year-old in my program to wear a mask even if the younger children, ages 2-4 years, are not required to wear a mask? Yes. You need to follow the state mask mandate which requires anyone age 5 and over to wear a mask when not able to maintain physical distancing and you are in a group of people beyond your household. You do NOT need to require children younger than age 5 to mask." Going forward, if your child has turned five please have him/her come to school with a mask on. If you do not have masks for your child, we will supply them. If your child is three or four, masks remain optional. Thank you for helping us follow guidelines!

Winter Weather We have been lucky with the weather and temperatures so far this winter... mother nature must have known that we'd be having pick-up time outside instead of in the hallway this year! However, if/when the weather gets worse, please be careful in the parking lot as it can get icy. Also, it is ok to wait in your car a couple of minutes at pick up time.
