KEY FACTS

- 2025 Tournament Date: February 15, 2025.
- Location: Thomas E Weightman Middle School, 30649 Wells Rd, Wesley Chapel.
- Each tournament averages **75-100 teams, hosting 750-1000 people,** including team members, coaches, family supporters, judges, workers and other officials.
- Teams complete in one of **six STEAM related problems**, investing many hours each year, developing a solution to solve the problem and presenting that solution through a skit that lasts 8 minutes or less, doing all the work on their own with no outside assistance.

FUNDRAISING GOALS

- Establish funding for consistent coverage of the many expenses to put on the regional tournament that are not fully covered by the portion of the registration fee allocated to that purpose, so we don't have to raise tournament fees for our teams and our board members don't need to shoulder these additional costs.
- Develop funding for grants for Title 1 schools who don't have the funds available to pay the membership and registration fees set by the state and national level, opening this opportunity to all teams regardless of financial ability.
- Establish funds to increase scholarship offerings to our senior program alumni.
- Raise funds to help offset the high cost of participation for those teams that earn a chance to compete at the World level. Each World team incurs costs averaging \$10,000 and our region sends several teams each year to World competition, many that struggle to afford this opportunity.
