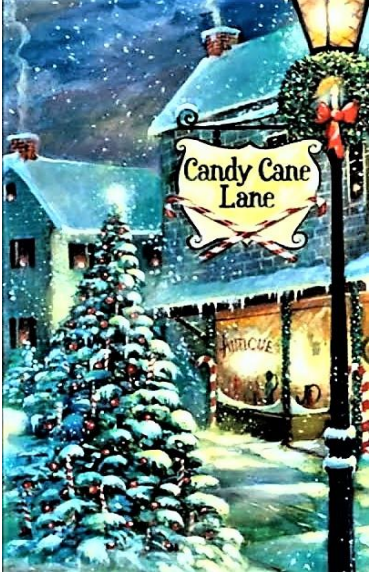


HOLIDAY MOVIES AND MUSIC
