5. **The Very Thought of You** by Billie Holiday from the film **Forever Young** (set in 1939) starring Mel Gibson and Isabel Glasser
6. **Begin the Beguine** (dance) starring Eleanor Powell and Fred Astaire in **Melody of Broadway 1940**
7. **Be Careful It's My Heart** from **Holiday Inn** (1942) starring Fred Astaire and Marjorie Reynolds
8. **Stuff Like That There** from the film **For the Boys** (set during World War II) starring Bette Midler and James Caan
9. **The Pacific: Date Night** (set in 1945) when troops came home from WWII, starring James Badge Dale and Caroline Dhavernas
10. **We're a Couple of Swells** featuring Judy Garland and Fred Astaire from **Easter Parade** (1948)
11. **It Doesn't Cost a Dime to Dream** from **The Lemon Drop Kid** (1951) starring Bob Hope and Marilyn Maxwell
12. **Singin' in the Rain** (1952) medley highlighting Debbie Reynolds and featuring her co-stars Gene Kelly and Donald O'Connor
13. [Secret Love](#) by Doris Day from **Calamity Jane** (1953)
14. **Seven Brides for Seven Brothers** (1954) **Barn Dance** (abbreviated)
15. [Brigadoon](#) (1954) starring Gene Kelly and Cyd Charisse dancing to **Almost Like Being in Love** and **Heather on a Hill**
16. **Schmigadoon** (2021) starring Cecily Strong and Keegan-Michael Key in SNL producer Lorne Michael's homage to the Golden Age of Musicals
17. **I'll Know** (1955) from **Guys and Dolls** with Jean Simmons and Marlon Brando (Frank Loesser music/lyrics and Damon Runyon characters)
18. **I'm in Love** from **South Pacific** (1958) starring Mitzi Gaynor
19. **Till There Was You** over the years starring Robert Preston, Shirley Jones, The Beatles, Piolo Pascual, Jennifer Sanchez & Thanh Tran
