- 4. **The Artist** (as silent films give way to talkies in 1927) starring Jean Dujardin & Berenice Bejo, directed by Michael Hazanavicius
- 5. **Stuff Like That There** from the film **For the Boys** (set during World War II) starring Bette Midler and James Caan
- 6. **Ella Fitzgerald** serenades **An American in Paris** (1951) starring Gene Kelly and Leslie Caron; directed by Vincente Minnelli
- 7. **Dancing in the Dark** from **The Bandwagon** (1953) with Fred Astaire and Cyd Charisse
- 8. **Ray (movie montage)** starring Jamie Foxx as **Ray Charles** (set in the 1950s and 60s), with Regina King and Kerry Washington
- 9. **UFO Roswell** from National Geographic Television accompanied by The Doo Wop Group's version of **I Only Have Eyes For You**
- 10. **Blue Moon** by **The Marcels** blended with AI imagery from Rocket Films-Movie (Japan) published to YouTube in 2025
- 11. **Another Day of Sun** photo montage featuring images from **La La Land** (2016) and some of the movie musicals it celebrated
- 12. **Guys and Dolls** (montage of 1955) starring Jean Simmons, Marlon Brando and Frank Sinatra (Frank Loesser music/lyrics)
- 13. **Somethin's Gotta Give** (1955) from **Daddy Long Legs** starring Fred Astaire & Leslie Caron, with **Sh-Boom** by The Chords
- 14. **Bob Fosse "auditions" Gwen Verdon** (1955) in **Fosse/Verdon** 8-part series (2019) starring Sam Rockwell & Michelle Williams
- 15. **People Will Say We're in Love** from Rogers and Hammerstein's **Oklahoma**
- 16. **Shall We Dance** from Rogers and Hammerstein's **The King and I** starring Yul Brynner and Deborah Kerr
- 17. **Pick-a-little, Talk-a-little** from **The Music Man** (set in the year 1912) starring Robert Preston and Hermione Gingold
- 18. **The Lady Loves Me** from **Viva Las Vegas** (1964) starring Elvis and Ann Margret
- 19. **My Fair Lady** montage (1964) starring Audrey Hepburn and Rex Harrison
- 20. **America** starring Rita Moreno and George Chakiris from **West Side Story** (1961)
