



- 10. **The Rich Man's Frug** from **Sweet Charity** (1969): Bob Fosse choreography starring Suzanne Charny & Shirley MacLaine
- 11. **Matchmaker** from **Fiddler on the Roof** (1971) starring Rosalind Harris, Michelle Marsh and Neva Small
- 12. **Ascension** from the film **Cocoon** (1985) directed by Ron Howard; featuring music by James Horner
- 13. **Mustang Sally** written by Mack Rice and made famous in 1966 by Wilson Pickett...this version from the film **The Commitments** (1991)
- 14. **Pleasantville** (1998) starring Tobey Maguire & Reese Witherspoon in a Gary Ross film with music from Randy Newman
- 15. **All I Ask of You** from **Phantom of the Opera** (2004) starring Emma Rossum and Patrick Wilson
- 16. **Don't Worry Baby**, by The Beach Boys from 1964, with Uma Thurman & John Travolta dancing in the film **Be Cool** (2005)
- 17. **That's All I've Got to Say** by Leighton Meester and Scott Grimes from **The Orville** television program (2019)
