### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All players and coaches **must** be YBOA Members. If you are already a member you will not need to pay again.
- YBOA Registration can be completed at [yboabasketball.com](http://yboabasketball.com). Please follow national rules according to the website.
- Once registered, please submit team roster to YBOA Hawaii at [yboahawaii@gmail.com](mailto:yboahawaii@gmail.com)
- **Teams should report to the gymnasium half an hour before their scheduled game time. At that time, a copy of your team rosters/waivers shall be turned in to the tournament site director. Please be prepared to show the player's birth certificate and photo ID at checkin.**
- Any team which does not turn in the proper forms will not be allowed to participate. The team will forfeit games until rosters/waivers are turned in.
- **No roster changes** will be allowed after sign-in sheets have been turned **in before the first game.**
- Coaches or supervisors must accompany their teams to check in.
- Players must compete at their own grade level or higher and compete only on one team in any age division.
- All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers on the back. Gym shorts CAN NOT have pockets. No duplicate numbers. Duplicate numbers will be assessed a technical at beginning of game.
- Teams will be guaranteed three games. This will be subject to unforeseen weather conditions or forfeiture by a team. A forfeited game is considered a guaranteed game. See below for further information.
- The decisions of the officials and site director will be final. Protests will be accepted.

- A site director will be provided for each gym (site) along with scorekeepers and timers.
- Teams are responsible for checking the official bracket board at the site and are responsible for being aware of any changes. Teams not ready at the proper time or site due to a posted change in time, court, or site shall forfeit that game. A five-minute grace period shall be allowed before a forfeit is declared.
- Team coaches, representatives, or parents should collect valuables. Gymnasium/YBOA will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Each team must furnish their own warm-up balls. Game balls will be furnished.
- If games run behind, a 5-minute maximum warm-up will be provided.
- A game in suspension (electrical interruption, etc.) will be resumed from the point of suspension if it can be resumed. If not, the game will be considered complete at the time of disruption and be considered a guaranteed game.
- Team trophies (Places 1 & 2) will be awarded.
- **There will be an admissions fee for everyone except players and coaches. The charge will be \$4.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students. Children under 10 are free. One pass will be good for one game day. Please have players and coaches get hand stamped at the door to avoid confusion when viewing other games in which they are not participating.**
- Phones and locker rooms are not available for use.
- A player must be in the 2<sup>nd</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades to participate (see National rules at [yboabasketball.com](http://yboabasketball.com))

#### *IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER*

- **If the tournament is cancelled, a processing fee of \$20.00 will be withheld with the remainder of tournament fee being returned.**
- **If the tournament has begun (commencing on the first game of the day), a 50% refund of tournament fee will be given.**
- **If at least one-half of the first day of the tournament has been completed as determined by the tournament director, no refund will be given.**

## YBOA DIVISIONS

September 1, 2025 – August 31, 2026

All players must meet the grade-level or age-exception criteria and present a copy of their birth certificate and current-year report card for verification.

Report cards must include the player’s name, school name, current grade, and current school year.

### Division

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 10 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 11 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 12 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 13 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 14 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 15 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 16 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 17 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Division

Player must be in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 18 prior to September 1, 2026.

#### Varsity Division (11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Grade)

Player must be in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade or under as of October 1, 2025 and not turn 20 prior to September 1, 2026.

**Note:** If a player exceeds an age limit for any grade level, that player must play at the next highest grade level in which their age meets the requirement.
