

A Great Alternative to Gutters

Protects doorways and gardens from rain. Sleek and hardworking - the V-11 Rain Diverter is a great alternative to traditional gutters.



1. Carefully lift the tabs of the roofing shingles where you are going to install the V-11 rain diverter. (The V-11 rain diverter is designed to be installed across one course of shingles.)
2. Place the V-11 rain diverter under the tabs of the roofing shingles.
3. Tilt the V-11 rain diverter in the direction that you want the water to flow.
4. Nail the V-11 rain diverter down with roofing nails.
5. Place roofing cement or some other acceptable sealant down under the roofing shingle tabs to secure them.
