

7. Green Keepers report.

Weather

A frustrating few months for golfers I'm sure, but we are doing our best to open the course/trolley's on when we can but we do need to consider the golfers health and safety manoeuvring around the course and also protect the course as best we can during this period of awful weather. We have now had over 8 inches of rain in the previous 3-4 weeks, 3 inches in the first 8 days of November already.

Project work has therefore completely halted, this includes, bunker projects, verti draining fairways, completion and seeding of the short game area, and some drainage installations. It has also put us behind with normal cutting regimes, top dressing, fertilising regimes, and no spray window for nearly 6 weeks. Tough times.

Greens

The greens are actually holding up well, still very firm with good grass sward health going into the winter. We have only been able to cut once per week for the previous 3 weeks due to the ground conditions. As soon as we are able to we will be applying a light dressing to take out any bobble and ensure a smooth ball roll, and spray our first monthly winter strengthening package.

Fairways

We will be commencing verti draining on the fairways as soon as ground conditions improve significantly in order to relieve compaction and aid drainage.

Tees

We were aiming to feed the tees once more in order to keep them in use before we move on to winter matts, we haven't been able to this so far. We are now using posts and rope to spread wear and direct traffic.

The 1st, and par 3s are now on winter matts, which, with the weather not improving, will more than likely remain on matts for the rest of the winter, and we aim to have the remaining tees off matts in early December.

All winter matts have now been cleaned and levelled; some were sprayed to kill off any moss also. We will be repairing/replacing any damaged sleepers this week.

Projects

We have inspected and unblocked the damaged drainage pipe on the 16th fairway and have since discovered that it is no longer the lowest point, so will therefore be installing a new drain alongside, taking water away and down the bank.

We aim to begin the next bunkers in line on our bunker plan, which are the front bunker on the 11th, and the left-hand bunker on the 15th.

The bunker on the 11th will be brought back away from the green slightly and made much more level. We will then build a new face which will be much easier to maintain.

The left-hand 15th bunker will be turned into 2 small pot bunkers, making them much easier to maintain and fixing the drainage problem. The approach to the green will also be widened. More information can be found on the green keeper's board in the golf shop.

Short game area

The short game area project is almost complete, with just shaping/tidying and seeding to finish. Due to the wet weather we were unable to complete firming up/levelling and seeding of the front section of the fairway or the outer mounds. However, we have had decent germination of grass on the green itself, and have since moved the germination sheets to the fairway. Many thanks
