Some of their favorite sensory activities are playing with simple musical instruments, books of different textures, small and large manipulatives they can bang, swipe, throw and chew on, and floating objects in water bags. They have even done some process art using finger paints, both messy and non-messy. They enjoy listening to a variety of music along with streamer shows, while watching me dance, and taking walks in the stroller throughout the center and visiting with the older children. 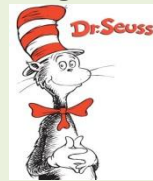
