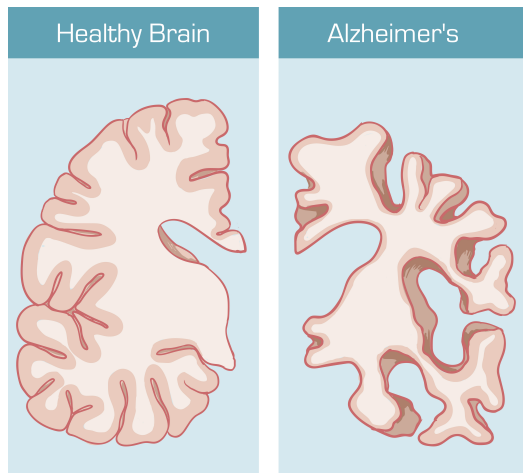


What if you could help a scientist cure brain disease? You can!

Brain science is brain health. A method called brain banking allows scientists to peer deeper into the brain than ever before. This technology preserves the nano-scale structure of the brain, which is small enough to fit inside the width of a human hair almost 100 times! This gives scientists the information to make new discoveries about how to reverse brain diseases like Alzheimer's.



How do I become a brain donor?

The key to brain banking is rapid preservation in under 30 minutes after death. Because of the time sensitive nature of brain donation, donors must pre-register for brain banking. When a donor approaches their final days of life, the hospice provider must contact us 24 to 72 hours before death for our team to standby for donation.

Donors must be altruistic individuals with a passion for advancing the progress of medical science and education. We encourage donors and their families who are passionate about science and want to be a part of the "final frontier" in brain research to register for brain banking.
