Pamela M. Staton has over 25 years combined experience as a casting director, talent executive, producer, and promotions & marketing executive. She has been instrumental in making 79 independent films that have gone on to receive distribution and/or honors from prestigious film festivals. Among the notable titles are 5th of July, an Amazon Prime favorite; All About You (highest selling DVD in the Urban market to date) starring Tony Award Winner and Emmy nominee, Renee Elise Goldsberry in her first film role; Restraining Order, Street Boss; Restitution; All About Us, featuring Morgan Freeman; and Playaz Court, named an "urban classic" by Variety magazine, starring a popular roster of recognizable faces early in their careers.



Pamela has been an executive in production, marketing, casting and/or programming for NBC, the Walt Disney Company, Black Entertainment Television (BET) and Warner Bros. She is an active associate member of the Casting Society Of America (CSA), Academy of Television Arts and Sciences (ATAS), Women In Film (WIF), Entertainment Industry Foundation (EIF) and Film Independent (FIND). Don Preston, Music Score Composer and Performer

Don's extensive list of credits spans decades. He is well known as the keyboard player for Frank Zappa's Mothers of Invention.

Preston has played and recorded with John Lennon, Peter Erskine and John Carter. He also has scored more than 20 feature films and 14 plays. He's the winner of numerous awards, and has performed with the Los Angeles Philharmonic and London Philharmonic. Known to jazz and keyboard aficionados for his pioneering contributions in the use of synthesizers and piano. Legendary clarinettist and composer John Carter dubbed Don Preston the "father of modern synthesis." His soundtrack performances include playing synthesizer on the soundtrack of Francis Ford Coppala's *Apocalypse Now*.
