





### **Writing activity**

This can be printed or written directly into the students writing journal. At the beginning of the story Edward Tulane does not know what love means to him. Throughout his journey, Edward discovers what it means to be loved but most importantly, he discovers what it means **to** love.

This writing activity invites students to reflect on the meaning of love. The first page is designed for grades 2-12, they can write about what they believe love is or what it means to them personally. The second page is designed for grades K-1, they can share who they love and why, then draw a picture of themselves with that person. This activity encourages self-expression and helps students connect with Edward Tulane's journey toward understanding love.

# Post-Show Activities

### **Order of Events**

### <u>Instructions</u>

### **Writing Activity**

Students will write a review of The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane, identifying memorable moments and expressing whether or not they would recommend the play to others. This will help develop their analytical skills and ability to express personal opinions based on textual evidence. Ask students to think back to moments in The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane that stood out to them—whether it was a surprising event, a powerful emotional moment, or a scene with memorable dialogue. Encourage them to jot down their top three favorite scenes or elements.

Share and Discuss: Allow students to share their reviews in small groups or to the class. Encourage them to discuss any similarities or differences in what they found impactful about the play.

## <u>Instructions</u>

#### **Word Search**

Students will look for the names of characters from the play.

This activity is designed to help reinforce their memory of the story and familiarize them with key characters. By searching for each name, students will practice visual pattern recognition and recall of plot details, enhancing comprehension of character relationships and roles in the play. The activity can be done individually or in pairs to encourage teamwork, helping students build vocabulary and collaborative skills while connecting to core Theater TEKS.




