First and last names are required 10 days before our tour. Seems, like we can drop names but not replace the name after that time.

- Valid ID will be required for each attendee scheduled for the tour. Photo ID, such as a driver's license or passport, will be required for each adult.
- Arrive 15 minutes before your tour so that you can check in at the desk.
- They encourage picture taking in the Experience Centre lobby . However, cell phones, cameras, purses or bags of any kind are not allowed on the tour. They have personal lockers available for us to use to store those items.
- Weapons are not allowed on the premises.
- Children with individual families must be at least 8 years old and accompanied by an adult. School daycare and civic groups must be 3rd grade or above.
- One (1) adult is required for every six (6) students.
- Toyota reserves the right to cancel or reschedule tours at any time necessary.

We are in the very preliminary planning for a Woodstock City walking tour.


We are considering a change to the celebration of a Summer Social this year.
