Our Speakers from Peter Harrison

Our October speaker was Brock Godfrey of the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre, North Bay, who spoke on Fraud Awareness for Seniors.

The Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre is a partnership of the OPP, the RCMP, and the Competition Bureau, located in North Bay. As October was Cyber Security Awareness Month, it was an obvious topic.



Brock explained their operation, including the Senior Volunteers with the group. He also mentioned several recent major news releases concerning computer, breaches, major fines and statistics. He then covered the top six scams targeting seniors, plus a few recent events to watch out for. He provided several tips to avoid telemarketing calls, and some computer tips as well.

Our Remembrance Day meeting on November 12th, will feature Zig Misiak on behalf of the Memory Project.

The Memory Project represents a community of over 1,500 veterans and Canadian Forces members who are committed to sharing their stories of service.

Zig Misiak is Polish by birth; his father was in the Polish army and his parents are Second World War survivors. Zig is a Second World War refugee, his family having come to Canada following the end of the war.



At 17, Zig joined the Royal Hamilton Light Infantry and has been a historical reenactor of the American Revolution and War of 1812. He is also an award-winning author. Zig will speak to us on the role of Poles in the Second World War.


