UK Covid 19 Localisation Modelling Competition Judging Criteria – Preliminary 5 November 2020

Entries will be evaluated based on the following Criteria

- 1. Completion of the Thinkific Course
- 2. Clear identification of the location including geographic boundaries and a narrative description of any unique characteristics including cultural norms relevant for the spread of Covid 19 and/or living and working conditions and local health issues
- 3. Quality and Consistency of the Data and creativity in identifying and using unusual data sources where limitations are identified within the location selected
- 4. Quality and completeness of the Data Documentation in the Spreadsheet provided including all sources and comments on any assumptions made
- 5. Quality of the model set up to mimic the historical record in the Local area
- Quality of assumptions about the base case future scenarios and analysis of implications for the timing of the lockdown release and what measures may be required after
- 7. Quality of scenario and sensitivity analysis to understand risks and uncertainties and key indicators to watch that may change decisions about the length of the lockdown
- 8. Clarity of recommendations and persuasiveness of the case
