350 Eugene - Guests Linda Kelly and Patty Hine: Linda and Patty shared the initiatives that 350 Eugene is currently involved in. These include building decarbonization (Fossil Free Eugene), pipeline expansion resistance, and forest protection. A few years ago, forest protection activists approached the climate activist community for advice, and they are now working together, as forest protection is crucial for addressing climate change. The U.S. Forest Service has proposed changes to the Northwest Forest Plan that could double or possibly triple logging on national forests and re-open mature and old-growth stands to aggressive logging.

Also mentioned was OCERA, which recently had a successful lobby day, and Oregon Just Transition Alliance, which is addressing energy affordability. They stressed the importance of focusing on the state and local level at this time. They also encouraged EK members to attend City Council meetings to support decarbonization efforts.
