

VILLAGE MILLS EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT

March 17, 2020

The Village Mills Emergency Services District met March 17, 2020 in the Wildwood Volunteer Fire Department Station. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Comm. Walton. Present were Comm. Fisher, Comm. Wornick, Comm. McDonald, WVFD Chief Odom and Marshall Odom.

The minutes of the February 18 meeting were approved. Motion was made to accept by Comm. Wornick and seconded by Comm. Fisher. The vote was unanimous to accept the motion.

WVFD WVFD is purchasing a phone and “hotspot” from FirstNet. Last quote in for hose purchase for Engine 7.

Building status Dirt work will start soon as it is dry enough to start work. Once the HVAC is finished the Fire Dept. will wire the station. Plumbing will go in as soon as electrical is completed. The insulation and siding will then be completed.

Treasurer’s report Treasurer’s report was read. A motion was made for approval by Comm. McDonald and seconded by Comm. Wornick. The motion was approved unanimously.

Old and New Business:

- 1) Discussed the New State SB1640/HB305 concerning ESD'S public access. VMESD8 will be opening our own website administered by Comm. Wornick
- 2) Phone purchase from FirstNet is in process. This phone number will be used for the public contact number for VMESD8.
- 3) Long discussion on new laws and rules presented by Comm. Wornick. The Commissioners discussed the rules for public speakers and adopted rules. This rule is titled VMESD8R2020-1. These rules will be posted on the website for public knowledge.
- 4) Commissioners discussed continued membership in SAFE-D. There was a motion made by Comm. Wornick and seconded by Comm. Fisher to continue membership. The motion was unanimously approved.

The next meeting was set for April 21, 2020

A motion to adjourn was made by Comm. Fisher and seconded by Comm. Wornick. The motion passed and the meeting adjourned.

General discussion The Commissioners discussed the Transparency Report requirement, Purchase of an electronic sign for the station and paperwork required for Commissioner who were just reappointed by Hardin County.
