BUILDING Discussed doors and handles for various needs in the Station. One more bid coming for the cabinets. Comm. McDonald will arrange for the annual generator inspection and meet the technician when needed.

Treasurer's report Report was read.

- 1) Continue discussion about Tax increase election No discussion.
- 2) There is a possible candidate for the empty VMESD8 Commissioner position for Tyler County. Tyler County Commissioner Joe Blacksher, Commissioner for Pct.1 is handling the application.
- 3) Possible VMESD8/WVFD rescue boat was discussed. Will be discussed in depth at a later date.
- 4) The need for a water pump to fill engines from other sources other than the fire hydrants was discussed. The engines are capable of "drafting", or pumping water from other sources on their own. There is no need for other pumps at this time.
