August 30, 2021 “called” meeting were read. A motion to approve was made by Comm. Wornick and seconded by Comm. Bales and was approved unanimously.

Treasurer’s report The treasurer’s report was read by Comm. Liles. A motion was made for approval by Comm. McDonald and seconded by Comm. Wornick. The motion was approved unanimously.

Old and New Business:

- 1) The tax rate proposal for 2021 was read by Comm. Liles.

It is moved that Village Mills Emergency Services District #8 adopt an ad valorem tax rate of \$0.03 per \$100 evaluation for the year 2021 . This rate is equal to that adopted for the year 2020. This proposed tax rate would effectively increase total taxes in Village Mills Emergency Services District #8 by 9.09% above the no-new-revenue tax rate. The proposed rate will have the effect of raising taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by \$2.50/year above the no-new-revenue rate.

The motion to accept was made by Comm. Liles and seconded by Comm. McDonald. The vote to accept was unanimous.
