April 21, 2020

The Village Mills Emergency Services District met April 21, 2020 in the Wildwood Volunteer Fire Department Station. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Comm. Walton. Present were Comm. Fisher, Comm. Wornick, Comm. Liles, Comm. McDonald and WVFD Chief Odom.

The minutes of the March 17, 2020 meeting were approved. A motion was made to accept by Comm. Fisher and seconded by Comm. Wornick. The vote was unanimous to accept the motion.

WVFD WVFD received a phone from FirstNet. The "Hotspot" is in back-order and is estimated to be delivered in July or August. An external antenna will also be shipped to WVFD. A 2003 Ford Expedition was donated to the WVFD. When weather is dry enough Comm. Fisher will be assisting Chief Odom by arranging the schedule for the Contractor to complete the dirt work.

Building status Contractor is still working on HVAC unit.

Treasurer's report Treasurer's report was read. No vote to accept. A vote will be taken "to accept" at the May meeting.

Old and New Business:

- 3)Discussed the Comptrollers report. This report will be discussed again at a later date.
- 4) The search for a "West Evacuation Route" was discussed. There will be more discussion at a later date after the new WPOA Board has had time to address this subject and if they support it.
