KENNY'S PHOTO ALBUM



This document is a digital family photo album of pictures I personally took (with some exceptions), between 1966 and 1980. They were the old fashioned 3.5 inch square prints, taken with an Instamatic type of camera. Early on, this was a generic brand like Bell & Howell. In 1969 my Aunt Teen (Catherine Frazier) gave me a Kodak version for my high school graduation. My original album used special plastic (vinyl?) sheets that held twelve pictures (six on front, and six on back), in a binder. The format will be similar in this digital album.

INTRODUCTION

I'm not sure when exactly I got my first camera, but my first shots (VA boy scout camporee) was in the spring of 1966 or 1967. I just loved the whole idea of photography. I forget where I got my early film processed, but in time I got most of them done at Revco drug stores. Some of these (not all) have a small date insert on the bottom right corner of the picture. That first camera only took black and white photos. The quality was poor, and you will see several flares of light and reflection present in some pics. When I got the Kodak, for a time I still used black and white film. You can see a stark difference between them and those earlier pictures. In a short time I started using color, but I confess there is a simplicity and beauty to those Kodak BW pics, that I greatly appreciate.

There are a total of 46 black and white images, split about half between the two cameras. Images 000-044 are all bw, and the remainder are all color except one - 214. I tried really hard to come up with a good separation of topics in sorting my pictures, but there are a few that are out of place. 040 should be with 209-215, 149 should be with 041-45, 028-039 should be with 219-239, and finally somehow I missed 557, which should have been with 481-518.

This photo album concentrates on the family of Russ and Edith Fisher, on our farm on Spud Run just below the forks. I began taking pictures just two or three years after we finished our new house and moved in.

This digital album will be part of a computer disk (CD-ROM or DVD-ROM) as a volume in my Kenny's Stuff archive series. The digital album has low resolution images, but the disk will contain full resolution images you can display and zoom in for detail. I think they were scanned at 300 dpi.

I have designed a media file numbering system for all my archive work. The image numbers mentioned in this album run from **000** to **557**; but the actual image numbers on the disk are **10000** to **10557**.

This document is written using Corel WordPerfect, then converted into a pdf file for easier distribution and use. Below is the side by side page format. I will refer back to it a few times in the next page or so, as I describe how this format works. At the top of both pages are group headings. These describe the topical subject, with additional info. At the left center of the right page are two lines pointing from a caption to the respective picture. Also you will notice dark lines in both pages showing separations from one group to another.

To view it as shown here, in Acrobat Reader, click [View - Page Display -Two Page View, then -Show cover page in two page view]. This will create the look I intended.



The layout and descriptions on the album pages are consistent throughout, except of course that the facing pages are mirrored, with the picture identifying notes are on the insides near the spine or binding; and the six pictures are on the outsides of the page.

At the top of every page is a topical description and an image number range (for that topic or picture group). See below about those groups, and the page headings.

On the inner part of each page (pics are on the outer part) are identifying and descriptive notes for each set of two side by side images. In each of these three sets, the notes are in three sections. First are the two image numbers (add 10 to the front for the real number), then a note for the left picture, then the right picture. Many pictures do not have any notes, but I have spaced those with only one note, so you can easily tell which image it references. In those cases where the pic had a date stamp, or those I could easily infer a date; will have that date noted. Most will be like "07/77", but those with only the year known will be like "1977"

All captions are in normal font. The dates are bold, and the image numbers are bold and italic. These distinctions should make these pages much easier to read.

In identifying people, I will use two formats. For members of our family (nine of us) I will just use the first name. All others will have an initial following the first name, like "**Dave D.**". An exception is 'Aunt Nancy', who was first married to John Detty, then had several more spouses. The order of naming will usually be left to right, but sometimes it may be top to bottom instead.

There is a section called Other People, which gives a numerical listing of image numbers, with names added. Where more than one person with the same surname, that surname is in all caps at the end of the line.

Topic Groups and pages

Because the groups (picture topics) rarely fall on even page boundaries, there will be a little confusion. Each page will have a heading that contains two elements. First is a group name or description that covers part or all of that page's images. Secondly is a key combination of numbers and special punctuation.

To avoid as many problems as possible, each page heading will have a range of image numbers, with some special punctuation. The range of numbers include the entire group of pictures, regardless of the images on the current page.

Look at the left page above (pics 318-323). It has the heading Fisher Reunion - Tar Hollow * 320-328 >, indicating the lower four pics on the page, plus five more in the next page. The preceding asterisk indicates there are at least one image on the page from another group. The right arrow indicates this group continues to the following page(s).

Look at the right page (pics 324-329). It has the same group heading, but has an asterisk instead of an arrow, indicating there is at least one more picture that belongs in the next group.

Left bracket (before) and right bracket (after) are used to indicate an even boundary between groups and pages. A bracket before indicates the start of the current group is the initial image on the page, and one after, indicates the end of the current group is the final image on the page.


Hopefully this system will help in navigating back and forth in the album. I know it may stil be a little confusing.

I originally scanned my album photos in groups of up to six pictures from Dec 2011 to Jun 2014. I then had the onerous task of cutting them apart into individual images. In July 2021 I was able to create the separate images, came up with my numbers for these photos, and began creating my digital album.

I am really proud of this effort to get these precious photos out there. As noted before, the visual pics in these album pages are sometimes hard to see, but the original full resolution images are on the disk, and you can open them, and pan and zoom all you like. Enjoy!

BACKGROUND & CONTEXT

As stated before, this album is all about our family's life and experiences on Spud Run Road in Ross County, Ohio. Most of the images are at our home (which we called "The Place"). My grandparents Eli Fisher and Amy Rogers were both born in West Virginia. Soon after they were married, Eli's double first cousin Clarence Garnes talked them into moving near Akron, OH to find work in the auto tire industry. They were only there a couple of years, then moved to Harrison Township, Ross County; and rented a farm from Harold Stanhope, about ten miles East of Chillicothe, on Spud Run Road. They would go on to buy that farm. Below is a USGS topographic map of the area.



You can see five red circles denoting places of interest. **C** is where the Fisher and Garnes families first moved. Eli and Amy were further back up the holler, with Clarence to the South, closer to Spud Run. Around 1926 there was a fire, and Fishers had to move to **E**, and built a new house there. That house would later be partly torn down to make a garage for Uncle Ralph (his house was just to the West). **B** is where Russ and Edith first had a home. After a move to Columbus, they bought a piece of ground from Ralph (**D**) that was our home for a few years. Around 1961 we bought "The Place" at **F**.

This part of the township is very rugged, with extraordinary ridges and hollers. Spud Run was on the SE border of Tar Hollow State Forest

Our family (w nicknames & birth year) consisted of Russ 1922, Edith 1929, John 1949, James 1950 (d infant), Kenny (Speed) 1951, Jean 1952, Amy (Ree!) 1954, Danny (Doodle!), Custer 1959, Charles 1961. Edith had eight babies in thirteen years. We attended Harrison Elementary and Southeastern High schools. John failed his first grade, so in the 1967/1968 school year, all seven of us were in school at the same time.
