KENNY'S STUFF



The image to the left is a graphic logo for something I call Kenny's Stuff. Last fall I began a couple of projects. One was a start to an Idea I have been planning for some time - an archive of computer disks, and playable DVD's preserving the history of all my extended families. Last fall after Edith's passing, and the cleaning out of her house, I created a series of USB drives

containing a great many scans of pictures and other items. These USB's were distributed to a few close family members.

This year I found a company that could duplicate my disks professionally. I republished the files from the USB onto a DVD-Rom, and added a playable DVD with the music from our 2008 gathering.

I had several of each made, and brought them this year. The future will see more archive volumes. These future volumes will include my own family album, and some info on the Fisher Sawmill. I still have a ton of pictures to scan yet, so it might be a while before I put anything about our more historical family photos.

Along with this archive of family data, I created a web site last fall. The URL is shown below.

The site is still very new, and is for now basically a skeleton of a future site. It illustrates some of my interests and hobbies. Family plays an important part of the site. It is not optimized for the small screen of a smart phone.

You must use either a pad, or a full computer screen to be able to navigate clearly.

Usually there are pictures you can click on to enter various sections, as well as buttons you can click to access some features.

It is still very much a work in progress. Files listed in the various downloads, are all PDF documents. Click on a file to view it, or right click to be able to download it. The Archive page has a report and in the future will have an order form. The RussEdith page has my Fisher Heritage book, and a document on the history of Fisher sawmills. The GetTogether page has all fifteen gathering reports, all the way back to 2007. I am in the process of creating images for each clickable section. For the time being, some of the pics may be generic, or make no sense at all; but you can still click on them to enter that section of the web site.

I need to do a bunch of work to get the site to a state where it is truly useful, but it does have a few files you can download. Hopefully by next summer it will be more complete, and I hope to have two or three more disks added to my archive.

At the present I have two versions of the disks. A simple disk with nothing fancy for \$5, and a fancy version with case, artwork, and professionally printed disk for \$10. In the future I will have an order form on my site you can download, print out, and send in an order, and of course I will have them at our get together.
