This paragraph shall survive termination of this Agreement.

Loss & Damage – Participant releases Committee Management, Sponsors, and the City of Zanesville, and their officers, elected officials, agents, volunteers, and employees of any liability for the care, custody, or control against loss, theft, vandalism, fire, or other damage to Participant's property which may occur during the event, whether resulting from fire, storms, acts of God, theft, pilferage, mysterious disappearance, bomb threats or other causes. All Participant property is brought to the event and displayed at Participant's risk and should always be protected by Participant.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Age Limit: Crafts with adults: Min age: 8 (appropriate guardian permissions need to be filled out)
 Absolutely NO ALCOHOL before or during the race. This will be grounds for expulsion from the race.
1. Innertubes are accepted either as a float or used as part of the construction of the craft.
 2. Craft must be of safe construction to safely hold and transport your crew and cargo.
 3. All Crew, including the captain, must be of good health and physical abilities which will allow them to participate safely in this event. (In questionable issues ATFBBR will have final determination)
 4. Each person must have a Coast Guard approved personal flotation device ON at all times. The life vest must be in excellent condition and must fit the size of the participant. **There will be an inspection of ALL craft and ALL crew. (Safety First)**
 5. No horseplay by participants which may be harmful to crafts or surrounding individuals.
 6. NO FIREWORKS
 7. Participants must remember you will have 2 bridges to navigate under. Make appropriate adjustments to your craft to pass under them.
 8. NO MOTORIZED CRAFT: "Physical Human power" is the only form of locomotion acceptable.
 9. All participants must stay aboard their craft for the duration of the race. If any crewmembers fall or jumps into the water, your craft will be disqualified.
 10. Decisions of the race committee are final without appeal of matters concerning the race.
 11. Race officials are empowered to decide at their discretion any cases not covered by existing rules.
 12. Participants under the age of 18 years of age must have parental/guardian signature on their release form. Race committee may request proof of age documents to confirm consent requirements.
 13. All participants must fill out an application to enter their craft in the race.
 - a. ALL crew must fill out a legal release form to participate in the race.
 - b. CREW CAPTAINS are responsible for check in and accounting for your crew and craft.
 14. ALL crafts, and any sections/pieces that become unattached, must be removed from the canal within 1 hour after finishing the race.
 15. Late arrivals may be disqualified.
 16. Craft must be placed in the canal and retrieved from the canal using the craft captain and crew. If help is needed you will need to bring them with you. We cannot guarantee there will be help available.

Acceptable Building Materials	Unacceptable Building Materials
Wood: Light framing you can lift and will float	
Plastic Barrels	<u>NO STYROFOAM WHATSOEVER</u>
Metal Barrels	(unless permanently encase inside a container)
Inner Tubes/	<u>NO GLASS WHATSOEVER</u>
Cloth/Rope/Cording	
These are general guidelines: There are many materials that can be used to create and build your craft. Keep in mind weight and strength and your goal. The craft needs to be sturdy enough to get up and down the canal and be towed. Most of all: We must keep safety a priority	All materials should be of substance and withstand water and the stresses of unloading to the water and being pulled out of the water and loaded up, after the race.
