
## Introducing our New Web-Based Student Database

March showers bring April flowers, and a new student database! We would like to introduce our new student database, Procare Connect. This system, and our current system, are owned by the same company, but we have made the decision to switch to Procare based on the simplicity of their system and the additional features it offers over our current system.

Procare enables us to use text messaging with our families in cases of emergencies. It gives our staff easier access to lesson planning formats and communication formats. You, as a parent, will still have access to a parent portal account and will still utilize an online link to register.

You'll continue to sign in and out using our tablets and/or phones

during drop off and pick up. Unfortunately, the new system will require you to learn a new timeclock passcode, but we'll be here to help you anytime you need it. Passcodes are automatically generated and assigned by the program so





Lindsay has entered all the students into Procare and you will be receiving a parent registration link that will provide you with access to set up your parent portal account. In addition, Lindsay ensured that each student's authorized contacts have been entered. These individuals will also receive a program-generated passcode that we will happily share with them if they ever need. If you need to make any additions or alterations to your child's information, please notify us.

Our plan is to make this transition as seamless as possible and will implement the use of the new system beginning on April 1. In the meantime, we'll be utilizing both programs to ensure that we have the kinks worked out prior to April 1.


