New Playground

2020 has been full of surprises and new ideas, and it's only March! Not only are we enrolling for a Jr. Kindergarten class for 2020-2021 and enrollment, overall, is going well, we are now entering a very exciting time when we'll begin raising funds to have our playground updated!

I have spent many months looking at different structures and speaking with consultants. I have identified two possibilities that will be reviewed by our Facilities Committee and the Department of Children and Families, Child Care Licensing.

Our current playground structure was installed in 2009, and while the structure itself is safe and in good repair, there are some improvements that could be made. The structure that will be installed will offer the same amount and variety of skill building, and enjoyment, with some fun interactive pieces. In addition, there is a plan to include musical instruments/panels in the installation.

The poured rubber surface under the existing equipment will be removed in order to install the new equipment and then a new layer of rubber surfacing will be added. The musical

instruments will be added on the west end of the playground, but will still allow for the use of the tricycles and riding toys.

We are currently brainstorming fundraising ideas. It is our goal to have the funds available to have the structure installed over our next Christmas break, December 2020.
