COVID-19 School Etiquette

- Your child can not attend school if he/she or a family member is awaiting COVID test results
- The Preschool Office should be notified if a student and/or family member tests positive for COVID
 - Your child can not attend school if they are exhibiting any symptoms of COVID/Flu/ Cold
 - It is recommended that you wait 4-7 days after exposure to a positive case of COVID-19 to be tested

Please join us in car line

Due to the increased cases of COVID-19 in our community and the understanding that the virus is spread more often from adults to children/other adults, we will now ask that <u>all families use our car</u> line for drop off and pick up beginning Monday, November 30.

We feel that all the students have become accustomed to their new environments and we strive to ensure our facility follows the best practices to keep our students and our staff healthy. In that effort, we would further like to limit the exposure of our building to as many outside individuals as possible. Should you feel that your child would be negatively effected by this practice, please reach out to the office immediately.

We will no longer staff an individual at the door. This individual, will instead, aide with car line to ensure a quick and safe process in the mornings and the afternoons. Ms. Lisa, Ms. Chiara, Ms. Isabella and Mrs. Finman will continue to assist with car line, as will Ms. Lindsay and Ms. Ashley.

Out of respect for our staff, we would like to encourage you to wear a mask as we assist your child in and out of your vehicle. This simply recognizes the measures we are taking to keep you and your child healthy and shows us that you want to keep us healthy as well.

We will also have someone available to help direct traffic so that we do not block 3rd St S. If you have any questions, please let us know.

Backpack Tips!

In our efforts to help your child be as independent as possible and to keep our car line running smoothly, please use these backpack tips:

- Your child's lunch box, snack and water bottle should fit inside your child's backpack; if you're child's backpack is too small to hold the lunch box, your child needs a larger backpack
- Small, non-essential backpacks should be left at home or in the car (they are not needed for school)
- Please place your child's snack inside his/her lunch box
- Your child should only carry <u>one</u> item into school, either his/her backpack (that holds the lunchbox and water bottle) or his/her lunch box (if not using a backpack)
- Your child is not required to carry a backpack
