Need something for your child to do this summer? Look no further! Ms. Claudia, Mrs. Kennedy, and Ms. Sarah will be conducting summer camp here at First Presbyterian Preschool! Camps will be available during the weeks of June 14-18, June 21-25, and June 28-July 2, from 8:30 am

to 12:30 pm each day. Online registration will be available beginning Feb. 22. Space is extremely limited and will fill quickly. Payment and registration is required to confirm your child's placement.

If space is available, registration will open to new, incoming students on March 2.

For the first two weeks, Ms. Sarah and an aide will host camp for students that will have completed our toddler and 2 year old program, while Mrs. Kennedy and Ms. Claudia will host camp for any students that will have completed our three year old program or our VPK program.

Enrollment in the preschool summer camps will be limited to 17 students each week, while the toddler/two camps will be limited to 12 students.

Parents will be asked to provide a morning snack, a lunch, and a water bottle for their child each day. A variety of projects and materials will be available each week based on the weekly theme.
