Now that the holidays are behind us, we can begin thinking of next school year! Enrollment for 2021-2022 will start soon! Enrollment will be completed online using our Sandbox Software database. A link will be provided for you prior to enrollment opportunities opening.

Church Members: Enrollment begins January 11

Current Families: Enrollment begins January 20

General Public: Enrollment begins February 1

VPK Eligible Children (age 4 by September 1): Parents must register at www.familyservices.floridaearlylearning.com for a VPK voucher. You will be asked to upload proof of birth and residency. Once the information has been processed, the voucher will be sent to you. *The VPK voucher must be presented to the Preschool in order to receive the discounted tuition rate.*

And as always, we're here to answer all your questions!

*At this time, we will enroll students based on full capacity (12-16 students per class with two teachers), with the understanding that this may change based on the status of the virus prior to the school year beginning.

Car Seat Safety

Your child's safety is crucial when they are in our direct care, and even when they are not. Placing your child in an appropriately sized and secured car seat is the best way to keep them safe while on the road.

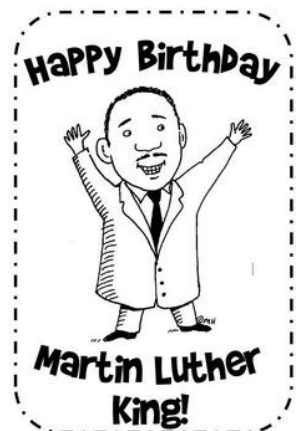
The state of Florida does require children, age 5 years and younger, to be secured in a 'crash-tested, federally approved child restraint device'. Not doing so could result in fines of \$163/per child and points against your driving record-resulting in higher insurance rates.

For your reference, we are providing a car seat safety flyer based on the American Academy of Pediatrics recommendations.
