I found my prototype woodchip car to model. I have 20 of them. Some will be full and others will be empty, depending on which direction they will run.


Membership Matters

We have added another model railroader to our club. Steven Costa has arrived from California and is experienced in wiring, DC and DCC, and computer interface.


Steven did not run at the Drain Show but was there to help with set up.


