What memories, treasures and or photos of prior swap meets do you have? Share them with the WCMRRC Newsletter.



February is here and a very busy month with two events, the Swap Meet and Train Show and the Oregon Logging Conference.

The Swap Meet and Train Show is February 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> at the Lane Events Center.

We begin set up on Thursday, February 15<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 noon to 5:00 PM. We will be placing signs up and dropping electrical for those vendors that would like to have electricity.

On February 16<sup>th</sup>, We will need a crew of 6 people, 7:00 AM to complete setting up our tables for vendors. At 8:00 AM we will need more people to help the vendors move in and set up for the show.
