What's New

"The next event is the Swap Meet and Train Show at the Lane Events Center beginning on February 13th from 12:00 PM to 5:00PM. We are allowed to hang electrical drops and signs only. On February 14th, we will be allowed to put in the information, raffle and ticket sales area along with the use of our club tables for vendor sales. We will start at 8:00 AM with vendors being able to set up at 10:00 AM.

We need a bunch of people to help with setting up on February 14th and help vendors move in. Sometimes there are opportunities for club volunteers to browse or purchase merchandise in advance.

Frame 1X6 ends. Sides should also be minimum 1x6 Тор Plywood 2X2 braced. May be attached to frame to fold out. Legs Primer This seals the wood. 12 AWG in six colors: Red, Black, Yellow, White, Green, Blue Wire buss Lay mainline roadbed cork Lay back track and sidings roadbed cork Lay mainline track Code 100 Connect feeders from bus to mainline 18 or 20 AWG solid copper Lay back track Connect feeders from bus to back track 18 or 20 AWG solid copper Apply scenery, and details. Buss connectors at each end. Buss line should have a terminal block strip at each end. Pass inspection.


