

#### **NOTE:**

T-Track specifications for HO and N scale use Kato Unitrack.

Kato Unitrack is measured in millimeters, so specifications for both scales use the metric system.

These are the packages of track you need to purchase for your module.

Single module	Kato 2-150	1 package
---------------	------------	-----------

Double module Kato 2-150 2 packages

Standard Corner inner Kato 2-210 1 package

Standard Corner outer Kato 2-220 1 package

#### T-Trak continued...

An expense we have to think about is our own Digitrax DCC power supply and controllers. Should the club purchase and own the power supply and controllers as they do for our DC operation? Or should one person own the power supply and a module or modules? Perhaps, whoever has the yard would have the power supply?

A single pack of KATO 2-150 has four pieces of track and costs \$17.50, it is all that you need for a single module. If you want to do a double module, then you need two packages. If you want to build a triple module, you will need three packages.

If you are wanting to own a corner, then you need a package of inner radius track KATO 2-110, and outer radius KATO 2-220. Both packages are \$19 each.

Landscaping is entirely up to the individual, and creativity is highly encouraged.

This week, I am cutting 2X2's to make the tabletop module legs. We still need access to a table saw and a drill press. The table saw requires a high tooth count blade, also known as a plywood and OSB blade.






