Written / originally conceived 2000 Durata 7 minutes Symphonic Poem "Oceans Dance" $MM \bullet = 56$; 4/4 meter Wandering through church modes Phrygian, Ionian, Lydian, Mixolydian and Hypomixolydian







Written / originally conceived c:a 2000 Durata 7 1/2 minutes (16 1/2 minutes total the 5th) Symphonic Poem "Frog Meditation"

 $MM \bullet = 74$; 4/4 meter a minor



~ 4th movement attacca to 5th movement ~ \sim note that there is a different ending if the 4th movement is played on its own ~

Fifth movement, Caccia

Written / originally conceived c:a 1998 Durata 10 minutes (16 1/2 minutes with the 4th) Symphonic Poem "Thus Spake Hippopotamus" Timpani (playing C[#] and D) creating a low but resounding murmur with the steam boat whistle (which is tuned $D_{\frac{1}{2}}$)

MM \bullet = 69 ; 4/4 meter Dwells on Phrygian C#
