 - 6. Copy of your parents' or gaurdian's most recently filed Income Tax Form or other suitable proof of financial need
 - 7. Please make sure application is signed by both the applicant and applicant's school counselor.

Who May Apply For A Scholarship?

All scholarship applicants must be graduating students at Dallas County high schools with a GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale); a proven record of community, school, and extracurricular activities; demonstrated leadership potential; demonstrated financial need; and a citizen or documented permanent resident of the United States. Scholarship applicants must plan to attend full-time at an approved college or vocational school.

Tell Me More About The Application Process.

Each applicant must submit a completed application accompanied by letters of recommendations from non-family members. The deadline for submitting your application is April 1 for Summer & Fall enrollment. Qualifying applicants will be interviewed by the Selection Committee, who will provide recommendations to the Board of Directors.

What Is The Value Of Each Scholarship To Be Awarded?

Scholarship awards will be made in amounts up to \$2,000 per academic school year, provided that the award does not exceed 50% of the estimated cost of tuition, books and fees. Scholarship awards may be increased based on certain demonstrated need. Scholarship awardees must maintain certain academic criteria and will be subject to review throughout the school year in order to retain their scholarship.

May I Renew My Scholarship?

Applicants for scholarship renewal must meet all of the above mentioned requirements and be enrolled in a an accredited institution of higher learning. Transcripts and other new information will be reviewed by the Selection Committee.
