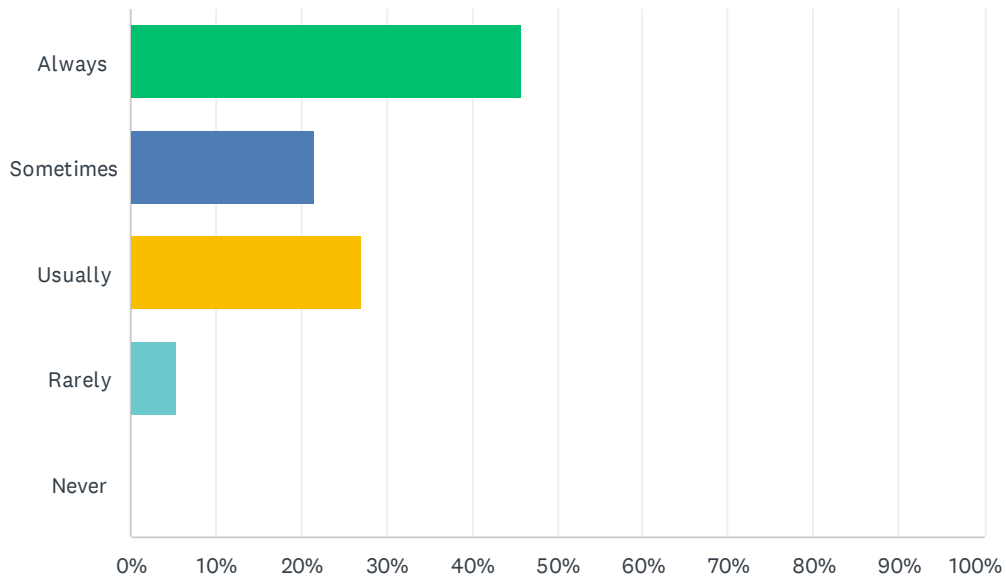


# Q1 How often do you read the blog posts from A Church Dismantled?

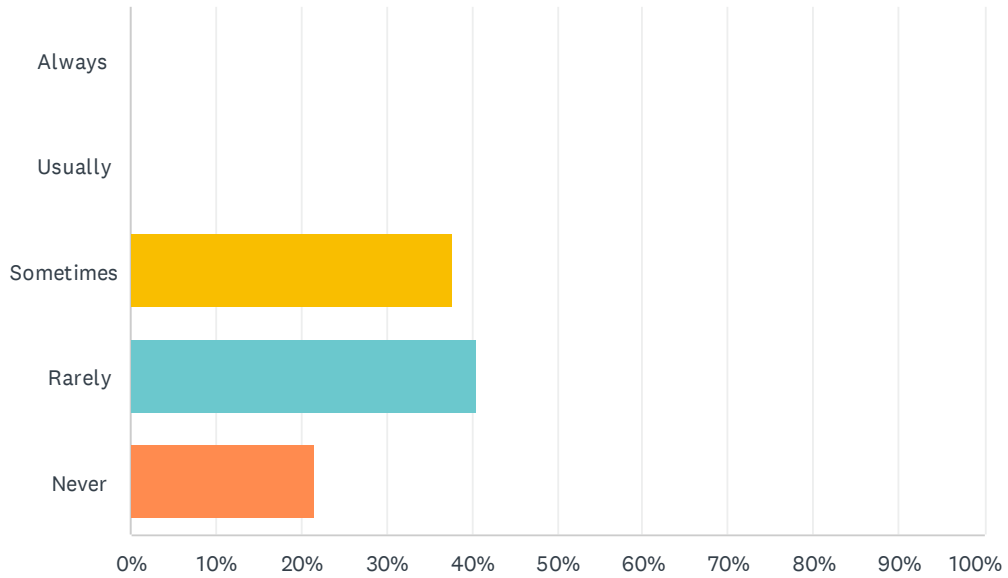

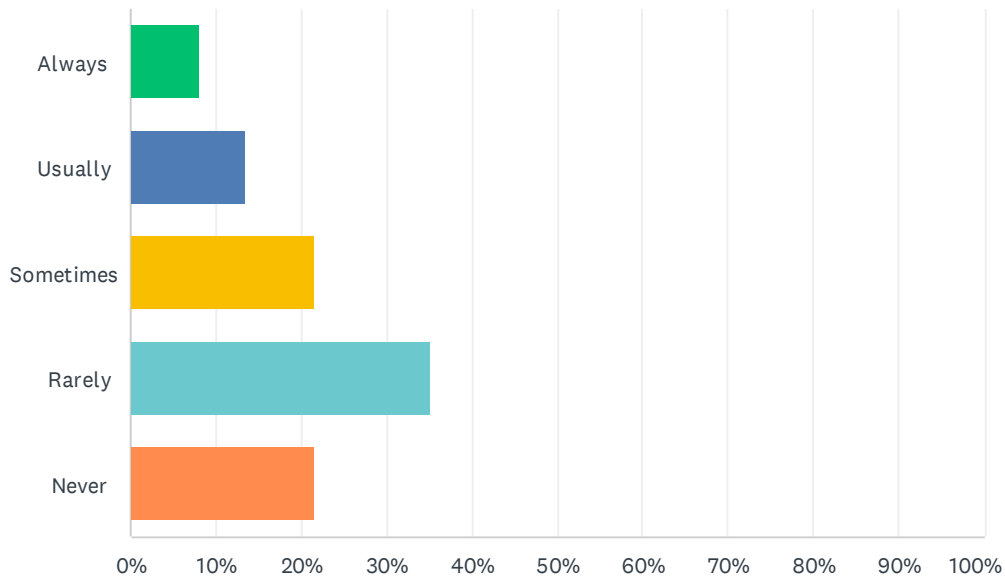

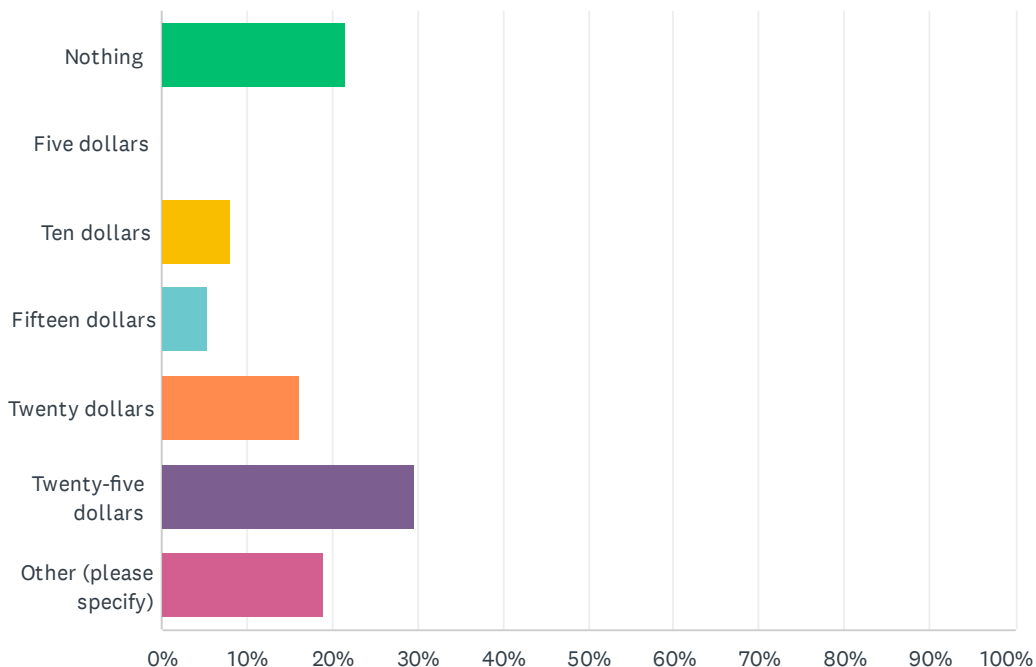
