2024 Assure End of the Year Report

Outreach: Assisted two individuals with counseling and medication expenses.

Assisted with funeral expenses for one individual.

Continued partnership with Wright State University (WSU) Lake Campus Psychology Club and Psychology Professor to deliver presentations on Mental Health and Suicide. Presentations have been done by students to at least 4 local organizations and continue to schedule in 2025.
