## OVERVIEW OF THE BOOK BY CHAPTER

*This spiritual book for ladies is a guide to help them discover for themselves the identity, calling, and direction God has for their life by learning how to TRANSFORM their thoughts, feelings, perspectives, and words; IDENTIFY their purpose, talents, skills, and spiritual gifts; and KNOW their direction in the Kingdom of God.*

### **Chapter One – Your Godly Identity**

This chapter focuses on *identity* and guides ladies through exercises designed for them to take an up-close-and-personal look at how they think and feel about themselves, how they perceive themselves, as well as what they say about themselves, whether positive or negative. It shows ladies how they should view themselves in accordance with God’s Word.

### **Chapter Two – Your Godly Calling**

This chapter focuses on *calling* and guides ladies in taking an in-depth look at purpose, talents, skills, and spiritual gifts. It guides and encourages them to seek God for their purpose, to identify their talents and skills, and to seek Him to know their spiritual gift(s).

### **Chapter Three – Your Godly Direction**

This chapter focuses on *direction* and guides ladies in seeking God for the instructions they need, once they know their identity and calling. It provides biblical examples of how ladies were directed by God. From these examples is the opportunity for other ladies to draw from their similarities.

### **Chapter Four – Spiritual Mentorship**
