A GUIDE TO THE MARRIAGE RECORDS

Soufflenheim church marriage records from 1788 to 1792, 77 total, are found in two series at the Archives of Bas-Rhin:

- NMD 1783-1792 Series 3E472/2 : 7 records, February 1792 to August 1792
- MS 3E472/4 (1788-1791) Series 3E472/4 : 70 records, January 1788 to November 1791

Marriage Records : Series 3E472/2

Series 3E472/2 contains 7 marriage records from February 7, 1792 to August 6, 1792, images 104, 105, 109, 110, 11, and 112, no introduction. The records are mixed together with baptisms and signed by Ignatius Hopp named Lemfried vicar, and on five occasions by Joannes Mockers schoolmaster.

[Note: An introduction in Latin to a baptism register in series 3E472/2, image 120, has a statement from vicar Ignatius Hopp named Lemfried similar to those in the burial register:

In year of Grace thousand seven hundred ninety two, on the 13 of September, by a decree of the French National Convention Ignatius Hopp named Lempfriedt, has been separated from his community and ejected from his parish and sent to exile, because of his constant faithfulness to God, the Catholic Religion, and the King, rejecting the impious oath that was called to the Civic oath, preferring to suffer a life of evils than obey to the scandalous and atheist Regicide decrees, and stayed so in situation of the Church for one year, month and fifteen days, until the Austrians were victorious over the French Regicides called Patriots, on the 18th of October of the following year he could come back to his parish with the exhortation of the people in reconciliation with the Church, celebrated an extraordinary Mass of Sacrifice and came back to his pastoral charge with the honours, and wrote down the events in this register the best he could, so that his successors will never forget.

Signed ; Ign. Hopp named Lemfridt, vicar.

Nota bene (margin) : In this book several entries were ill positioned and detected as not on normal date and the right parents have neglected ; but the information is considered as true.]

Burial Records : Series 3E472/4

Series 3E472/4 contains 70 marriage records from January 7, 1788 to November 21, 1791, images 2-42, with an introduction in French for each year. Records from January 1788 through June 1788 are signed by vicar Andreas Veith and schoolmaster Joannes Mockers. Records from July 1788 through November of 1791 are signed by vicars Felix Rumpler and Ignatius Hopp named Lemfried, primarily by Rumpler, and Joannes Mockers.

The present record containing ten pages has been attached and signed with initials in conformity to the decree n°2 and to the Royal Declaration in date of 21st October last, by us, esquire, counsellor of the King and royal bailiff in the bailiwick of the Upper Prefecture of Haguenau, this 31 December in year 1787. The present register of marriages of the parish of Soufflenheim containing twelve pages has been by us François Georges Louis Rothiacob bailiff of Neubourg and other places, judge named for the administration of Justice in the Grand Bailliage of the prefecture of Haguenau, numbered, parafed and signed, in conformity to the declaration of the King of year 1787, today the 11th December 1790. ***Partial Record, Heinrich Jaeck and Magdalena Schwartz Marriage, circa February-April 1790, Source Mark Drexler**

Partial record (signatures present) -- series 4, image 20 (original register page 4); fits in sequence between records of 15 February 1790 and 20 April 1790:

This almost certainly represents the marriage of Heinrich Jaeck and Magdalena Schwartz. Heinrich Jaeck's signature here matches -- albeit imperfectly -- that on the baptism/birth records of the two known children of that couple. Ignatius Jaeck signed the partial marriage record, and was described as the groom's brother. Heinrich and Ignatius were known sons of Ignatz Jaeck and Gertrud Meyer. The signature of Ignatius Jaeck here matches that on Ignatius Jaeck's marriage record of 4 February 1788 (4/4).

None of the signatories (other than the groom) is obviously related to the bride.

The date range of the partial record is very close to the dates of 24 and 26 January 1790 reported for the marriage contract of Heinrich Jaeck and Magdalena Schwartz (unfortunately, the marriage contract indicates that the marriage had already taken place -- though not explicitly in church).

Magdalena Schwartz was, at the time, the widow of Joseph Endres (and daughter of Heinrich Schwartz and Barbe Schmuck).

****Catharina Strom Origin, 09 February 1789, Marriage Record, Source Mark Drexler**

Catharina Strom's village of origin is Kempten. The name appears again, more clearly, in Catharina's death record. The best choice for *which* Kempten -- one that accounts for all of the place names mentioned in the marriage record -- is in the Rhineland-Palatinate region.

The key word in the marriage record is "Moguntini" This is one of several similar Latin spellings for the city of Mainz (on the Rhine, perhaps 80 miles north of Soufflenheim). The following word in the record is "Bingensi", which can be readily interpreted as 'Bingen' -- a village about 10 miles west of Mainz. Those two places lie on a short stretch of the Rhine running east-west, and appear to 'bookend' an area known today as 'Mainz-Bingen'. This named area comprises a near-continuum of villages and hamlets; and it seems likely that in 1789 it was likewise a named area and was called "Moguntini Bingensi" in the record.

Immediately east of Bingen is the village of Kempten am Rhein (probably known as simply 'Kempten' in 1789).

The marriage record referred to Kempten as being in an Archbishopric, which fits the known history of the Mainz diocese.

Concurring evidence for Catherine Strom's birthplace is found in her civil death record of 10 March 1824. Her husband reported that she had been born in Kempten, jurisdiction of Mayence. 'Mayence' is the French spelling for Mainz.

There is another place of importance mentioned in the marriage record. The marriage banns had been posted at "Cathedrali Spirae", which is a fairly clear reference to the cathedral at Speyer (about 40 miles south of Mainz and in a different diocese). Since it was customary to post banns in the home parish(es) of the bride and the groom, this indicates that Catharina was a member of the cathedral parish, i.e., she was living in Speyer. Unfortunately, the parish name in the marriage record is not clear to me. The priest's name is Frederici Josephi Schwartz, pastor of St ____, and he appears to be serving with special license as Most Reverend Ordinary.

Michael Martin and Margaretha Lehmann : Today seven January in year thousand seventeen eighty eight, after three publications as usual in the catholic church in our local parish church and two in the parish church of Schirrhein in as witnessed by letters sent by Reverend Vicar Lapp, in the named parish church, and dated on the seven of the same month and year, as mentionned above, received here and sending us the power of pronouncing the sacrament, as no hindrance has been revealed, and that the common consent has been received previously, by me undersigned in the face of the Church have been married : Michael Martin, son of Martini Martin, burgher and joiner in Schirrhein and of deceased Catharina Schneider, parishioner in Schirrhein, one side, and Margaretha Lehmann, daughter of deceased Michael Lehmann, burgher in his life and hand worker in Soufflenheim, and of Maria Anna Linck his widow, surviving and our parishioner here, on the other part. In presence of witnesses Joseph Mosser, burgher and farmer, Jacob Lehmann, farmer, and cousin of the bride, Michael Fridmann, inn landlord of Inn "The Eagle" and Jacob Winsch, potter, all of them burghers and living in this place, who undersigned with me, except the bridegroom and the bride who declared they could not write and apposed their sign. Signatures: Sign x of the bridegroom, sign x of the bride, Joseph Mosser, Jacob Winsch, Jacob Lehmann, Michel Fridmann, Andreas Veith Vicar in Soufflenheim.

Sebastian Stoll and Maria Anna Kieffer : Today the twenty first of month April in year thousand seventeen eighty eight, after three publications of banns as in use in the catholic church, in this parish church of Soufflenheim made openly, and no hindrance having been revealed, after I had received their mutual consent previously, have been married by me undersigned in the face of the Church Antonius Stoll major of age, son of Sebastian Stoll burgher and farmer and of Maria Anna Dangel, couple here, one side, and Maria Anna Kieffer, minor of years, daughter of Philipp Kieffer burgher and hunter living here, and of deceased Magdalena Brodchi in their lifetime a couple in Soufflenheim and living here, on the other side, both living in our parish. Were present as witnesses the fathers on both side of bridegroom and bride, Joseph Daul, burgher farmer and guardian of the bride, Joannes Mockers schoolmaster, all burghers in Soufflenheim who undersigned with the new married and me. Signatures: Antoni Stoll, Maria Anna Kieffer, Bastian Stoll, Philipp Kieffer, Joseph Daul, Joannes Mockers, Andreas Veith vicar in Soufflenheim.
