
# **SOUFFLENHEIM 1753 CHURCH ACCOUNT**

The 1753 church account of St. Michaels's in Soufflenheim, listing all income and expense. Found at the Archives of Bas-Rhin, G6614, 26 pages. Money in gulden, schilling, pfenning. Wax tax by weight: pound, viertel or fiertel (quarter of a pound), and loth (half ounce) and paid in its equivalent in money.

As accounted in Income section in money were sold 21 fiertel 3 but on this was given to the schoolteacher as part of his salary 5 fiertel.

So that this account has been presented in the place as usual for an account sent for ratification as it needed legal approbation in presence of Herr Frantz Antoni Streicher, vicar, also Andres Vögel, provost, and the main accounter of this passed in Soufflenheim on the 15th of June 1754.
