Soufflenheim Genealogy Research and History

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Soldiers from Soufflenheim in the Royal Bavarian Infantry from 1737 to 1763 and the Alsace militia from 1753-1758. The company name in the images is that in the books, which is the name of the commander on the date the roll was begun, but a particular soldier may only have enlisted after a command change. I have tried, where possible, to identify the specific commander the soldier served under. When other soldiers transferred in and out, the date and commander at the time of the transfer is given in the listing of their other company, and by finding that I could sometimes bracket the soldier's service within known command, but in other cases there weren't transfers at informative times. Possible company commanders remaining unconfirmed are in brackets, those confirmed as commanders during [at least a portion of] the soldiers' service are not.

Corsivier numbers are for each roll (not bound books, but the individual rolls being bound together). He first arranged the regiments. Infantry first, then specialized troops (artillery, cavalry, guard, militia), and within categories in an order loosely based on the later numbers of the regiments they would evolve into (or be merged into), then the surviving rolls for each regiment are arranged chronologically. With them all lined up, he just numbers them sequentially, starting at 1 and going well above 3000, but this has the advantage of being a unique identifier for each individual document that can be specifically identified and dated (as opposed to each individual book, the archive catalog numbers, that can contain 1-5 documents).

The battalion numbers are from Corsivier, This information might also be provided on the face page of the rolls, which gives a brief description, date and is signed by the regimental major, versus being deduced from context (e.g. you would only need to identify one battalion as the 2nd to know the other was the 1st, and they could be followed through time from one known instance). There may also be instances where it is Corsivier who is arbitrarily calling one battalion 1st and the other 2nd based on the order in which their rolls are bound.

The roll dates are from Corsivier. The date also appears on the face page of the roll (if the face page survives). The roll date is when the roll was begun, but many of the soldiers listed joined after that date.

*19 February 1757, Johannes Irr, age 18, son of Joannes Irr and Magaretha Killy, soldier in the Royal Bavarian Regiment (Inventory of Magaretha Killy, Roeschwoog 6E33/62). He is the one Royal Bavarian soldier not found in the muster rolls. There is a gap in the rolls that more or less spans the duration of the Seven Years' War. GR 1 Yc 852 has its last entries in 1756, and an annotation that it ran through 1757. Johannes Irr could have enlisted in 1757 after this book ceased to be kept. The cessation may reflect the commencement of a new book since lost, or just a continuation of the decline in record keeping that can be seen in the last several years of book 852. GR 1 Yc 853 was commenced in 1763. That gives us a 6-year window, which is longer than most enlistments during this period. If Johannes Irr enlisted in 1757 after the older book was no longer updated, and served for, say, 5 years, he would have been out already before the newer book commenced.

ALSACE MILITIA

There is a set of rolls for the Alsace militia, technically Strasbourg militia with responsibility for Alsace. There were two battalions, Colmar and Strasbourg. The former, found in roll SHD/GR 2 Yc 46, was entirely of Haut-Alsace origin, while the latter, SHD/GR 2 Yc 118 (Corsivier 3244), included four men with Soufflenheim connections. Two were Soufflenheim natives. Of the others, one was from Soufflenheim at the time of their service though not native, the other from a village within the jurisdiction of Soufflenheim, to which his service was credited. Typically there were quotas for militiamen each town/area was expected to provide. This last probably was only associated with Soufflenheim in an administrative sense and not really a Soufflenheim person. There are no page numbers, and no distinguishing information in the page headers.
