Soufflenheim Genealogy Research and History

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Church records from St. Michael's in Soufflenheim begin in 1743. Earlier records are found in other communities, particularly in Haguenau during the 17th century.



Saint Nicolas, Haguenau, 19th Century

“Frederick the 1st “the Red Beard” was crowned emperor in 1152. He wanted to build a sanctuary for the numerous pilgrims who were coming to the town of Haguenau to venerate the Holy Relics and to admire the royal insignia which were in the imperial chapel of the Hohenstaufen castle. Many among these pilgrims were sick or poor. In 1189 Frederick “the Red Beard” wrote an edict saying that a home must be built “to give bread to the poor and shelter to the penniless and homeless”, which would be run by the “Prémontrés” monks under the patronage of Saint Nicholas. This hospice was located outside the first surrounding wall of the town and its sanctuary became the parish church of the Northern part of the town.

The social, economic and religious crises of the Middle-Ages forced the monks to sell the monastery to the town. During the Thirty Years War, the parish had no priest and was thus ministered by the Augustinian and Dominican Friars. After the occupation of the town by French troops in 1635, the “Prémontrés” monks from “Allerheiligen” in the Black Forest, bought the church and again took over the

service in Saint Nicholas until the French revolution in 1789. Since then, the parish is ministered by the secular clergy.” (*Origin of the Parish of Saint Nicholas*, Saint Nicholas Parish)

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Saint Georges, Haguenau, 19th Century. Construction began in 1143.
It was replaced around 1200 and expanded in Gothic style from 1250 to 1283.

HAGUENAU

The oldest Soufflenheim religious records are found in the churches of Saint Georges and Saint Nicolas in Haguenau from 1603 to 1683. All have been completely translated.

EVA SCHWENZELL

11 September 1603 The Day of Nativity of Maria, St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

Baptized by me Laurent Mosch, chaplain in St. Georg : has been baptized a child named Eva, daughter of the honorable Walter Schwenzell from Soufflenheim, now in Kaltenhouse, and to his wife Appolonia native of Steinfeld. Godparents : Georg Thomas Hansen in Klinghausen, Eva, daughter of Hans Becht in Kaltenhouse, and Michel Fussel's wife.

CATHARINA LÖFFLER

27 February 1611 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

1611 the 27th of February has been baptized by me Georg Herrmann for present time a vicar in St. Georg, a daughter named Catharina. Her parents are Hans Löffler from Bergheim near Oberkirch, and Barbara daughter of Claus Miller also from Bergheim. This is a legitimate child who received as godparents : Laurentius Tuchsherer from Soufflenheim, Barbara Schäb from Wittersburg near Büssweyl, and Maria Kuntz from Haguenau, native there.

JOANNES JACOB KRAUT

29 July 1622 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

29 July 1622. Joannes Jacob. Parents : Peter Kraut shepherd and Magdalena his wife. Godparents : Hans Steuer burgher of Soufflenheim, and Catharina, wife of Vix Gerwein. Baptized by vicar Kuntz.

GERG HAUSS & TRELY

03 October 1626 St. Nicolas Parish, Haguenau Marriage

Were married : Gerg Hauss from Schirrhein, and Trely, widow of Claus Welsch in his lifetime a burgher in Soufflenheim. Witnesses : Hans Niclaus Volmer, burgher here, and Catharina from Soufflenheim.

MICHAEL SCHWEICKHAUSER & ANNA

23 August 1630 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

In 1630 23rd of August were married Herr Michael Schweickhauser, inn landlord and member of the council in this city, and Anna widow of deceased Ulrich Duntz in his lifetime a mayor of Soufflenheim. Witnesses : Georg Edelmann, bedell, and his wife.

MICHAEL WEIDENMÜLLER & EVA

26 October 1630 St. Nicolas Parish, Haguenau Marriage

Were married Michael Weidenmüller from Soufflenheim, son of Michael Weiden burgher and baker in Soufflenheim, and Eva, deceased Hans Einninger, in his lifetime a burgher and baker also member of the council, his widow. Witnesses : Michael Hüttendorffer and Anna Gedler.

JODOCUS WANTZENBURG & MARIA BURGER

28 June 1631 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

Were married Jodocus Wantzenburg, native of Strasbourg, his parents Cosmann Wantzenburg and Catharina Gillenisch, and Maria Burger, native of Strasbourg, widow of deceased Hans Burger in Soufflenheim. Witnesses Nicolaus Mentz from Nedrestet, caporal, and Heinrich Wirtenberg, also former soldier.

MATHIAS GYG

12 February 1632 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

12 February 1632. Mathias. Parents : Barthel Gyg, game keeper in Soufflenheim, and wife : Maria. Godparents : in name of a godfather in Surbourg is represented by Claus Rolly game keeper in Eschbach, and godmother was Maria, wife of the clerk in Soufflenheim.

CLAUS HALLER & MARIA WAGNER, HANS GOETZ & MARIA URICH, WAHL WOLFF & MARIA RUPERT, HANS...

04 April 1633 St. Georges, Haguenau Marriage

The 4th April have been married with agreement of the well honourable respected Simon Kuentz, vicar in Soufflenheim, who also asked me to marry his parishioners of Soufflenheim, because of the tumult of war:

So:

A. Claus Haller from Bischwyhr in the Margraffschafft, and Maria, Martin Wagners in Soufflenheim legitimate daughter.

B. Hans Goetz from Soufflenheim, son of Jacob Goetz there and Maria, daughter of Velten Urich junior.

C. Wahl Wolff in Soufflenheim, and Maria, Hans Ruperts daughter.

Hans ...[No last name or other information given.]

Witnesses : besides the bedell of Soufflenheim and Margreth Hans Urich Baur, in his lifetime a bather here his widow, the new married themselves. [Margareth is a woman and the widow of Hans Ulrich Baur, a bather]

JOANNES WOLF

28 May 1635 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

28 May 1635. Joannes. Parents : Georg Wolf from Soufflenheim. Wife Christina. Godparents : Niclaus Gangloff and Susanna Weber, former clerk's wife. Baptized by Carl Piltirus.

GEORGIUS SCHLIEFFER

24 March 1650 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

24 March 1650. Georgius. Parents : Hans Schlieffer from Soufflenheim and wife Margaretha. Godparents: Hans Kuri and Ottilia Dürr, both single and from Soufflenheim

MICHEL BORHAR

10 October 1650 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

1650 10 October. Michel. Parents : Mathis Borhar in Schirrhein. Wife : Catharina. Godparents : Georg Eisenmann from Zeelarnsberg and Veronica, wife of Martin Kuri in Soufflenheim.

MARIA MERCKEL

09 March 1652 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Baptism

Maria. Parents : Hans Georg Merckel, burgher and baker also bedell in Dürrenbach and Ottilia his wife. Godparents : Lorentz Schmidt from Soufflenheim, in present time employed in the cloister of the Old Hospital, and Maria, wife of Martin Schwebel. Baptized by Hugo Syrnouth, canon of the Prémontrés Convent.

LORENTZ SCHMIDT & MARIA BERNHARDT

13 January 1653 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

Marriage publications - 02 December 1652. Married Lorentz Schmidt, son of deceased Lorentz Schmidt, in his lifetime a burgher in Soufflenheim, and Miss Maria, daughter of Hans Peter Bernhardt, from Gunstett. Witnesses Martzloff Voltz in Gunstett, and Hans Peter the bride's father.

CATHARINA, DAUGHTER OF THE BAKER IN SOUFFLENHEIM

05 January 1669 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Burial

1669 05 January has been buried the most innocent young virgin named Catharina, daughter of the baker in Soufflenheim, and niece of Master Antony Lusch inn landlord of place named "The Eagle" on his

sister's side, in his absence and after the death of her mother, the young girl and orphan has been placed under his assistance after death of her parents the 4th of this month for three years, until the fatal day when a most serious fever stroke her, which has been noticed by the mother of the family, but instead of sending for the usual physician she asked for another one, who did not know what should be administered and suggested, as medicine and pharmacy, and so the belly of the tender girl, my most virtuous parishioner, owned with all beauty and most lovable, was suffocating because of this fever, and all in the family around her lamented when on the eighth day of her suffering she finally died, on the very day when Rachel cried the loss of her sons and could receive no consolation, this excellent soul, who has not been treated the right way, but left aside, be accepted among the Innocents, O! O! that those guilty of her fate should suffer their crime.

JOANNES JACOBUS SCHÄFFTER

04 July 1674 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Baptism

Joannes Jacobus. Parents : Hans Jacob Schäffter, provost in Soufflenheim and Maria his wife. Godparents : Caspar Heid, son of Jörg Heid burgher and butcher and Miss Maria, daughter of deceased Jacob Loser, in this lifetime a burgher and baker. Baptized by father Norbert.

JOANNES JACOB SCHÄFFTER

14 July 1674 St. Nicolas Parish, Haguenau Burial

1674 on the same day (14 July) has been buried Joannes Jacob, young son of Johannes Jacob Schäffter, mayor in Soufflenheim.

OTHILIA MERCKEL

02 October 1674 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Baptism

Othilia. Parents : Andres Merckel, miller in Soufflenheim and Barbara his wife. Godparents : Paul Gerwig junior burgher and barreler, and Othilia, Hans Schitter's, burgher in Forstheim his wife. Baptized by Reverend Father Nicolaus Schwartz, canon of this place.

BARBARA, WIFE OF ANDREAS MERCKEL

07 December 1674 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Burial

1674 07 December was buried after she had received the holy unction Barbara, Andreas Merckel's, the miller in Soufflenheim his legitimate wife. Rest in peace!

JOANNES GEORGIUS GIGER

1675 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

Joannes Georgius. Parents : Mathias Giger burgher in Soufflenheim and Barbara his wife. Godparents : Mathias Breÿ burgher in Soufflenheim, Anna Catharina Segmiller, wife of Joannes Wendel Segmiller baker and burgher in Haguenau.

ANNA MARIA GOETZ

17 June 1675 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Burial

In year 1675 the 17 June has been buried, Anna Maria, young daughter of Georg Goetz, in his lifetime a burgher in Soufflenheim. Rest in peace!

[On-Line Page 112/210. Anna Maria, abandoned young daughter (relicta filiola) of Georgii Götz of Sufflenheim. The term 'abandoned' indicates that Georg was deceased.]

ANDRES MERCKEL & CATHARINA WURTZ

19 October 1675 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

Married the honorable Andres Merckel burgher and miller in Soufflenheim, and Miss Catharina, daughter of Görg Wurtz from Espach. Witnesses the fathers of both bride and groom, and Catharina, widow of Jacob Loser.

JOANNES BREY

27 December 1675 St. Georges, Haguenau Baptism

27 December 1675. Joannes Brey. Parents: Joannes Brey burgher from Soufflenheim and Agnès his wife. Godparents : Mathis Gieger, burgher and hunter from Soufflenheim. Barbara, legitimate daughter of Georg Christman burgher in Kaltenhouse.

BARBARA GROSS

03 March 1676 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Baptism

Barbara. Parents : Benedict Gross a mason in Dürrenbach and Anna Maria his wife. Godparents : Niclaus Sontag, burgher in Soufflenheim and Catharina, wife of Jörg Saur in Dürrenbach

JACOB WURTZ & CATHARINA

20 June 1679 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

Were married the honest young man Jacob Wurtz son of honest Georg Wurtz burgher in Soufflenheim, and Catharina, widow of deceased Johannes Georg Lehmann burgher of Haguenau. Witnesses Blasius Haber and Maria, wife of Christmann Heidt.

Comment: On 11 May 1675 at St. Nicolas, Haguenau Joannes Georgio Leheman married Catharina, daughter of Joannis Michälis Sontag, burgher of Haguenau.

THOMAS STAUDINGER & EVA SCHOFF

17 October 1682 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Marriage

Were married the honest young man Thomas Staudinger, son of Peter Staudinger deceased once a burgher in Soufflenheim, and Miss Eva, daughter of honest Matthis Schoff burgher of this place. Witnesses : the father of the bride and Catharina, wife of Georg Geitner.

NB: These two young people did not celebrate the publications of bans, not because the bishop or vicar would have forbidden, but death; as the groom, on the very day of marriage, recognized that he had a hot fever, which he suffered seven days long, and died, leaving his wife alone.

THOMAS STAUDINGER

06 November 1682 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Burial

1682, 06 November has been buried the honest young man Thomas Staudinger native of Soufflenheim. He intended to celebrate his wedding on the 5th of November, but a hot fever caused that he was taken away by a premature death, and called to celebrate the wedding in Heaven, where he will share this with the others called to eternal Peace.

MARIA ANNA DANNI

27 August 1683 St. Nicolas, Haguenau Baptism

Maria Anna. Parents : Hans Jacob Danni from Soufflenheim and Barbara his wife. Godparents : Hans Jacob Dietrich burgher and smith, and Anna Ursula wife of Hans Jacob Melzheim, a tanner.

NICOLAS SCHNEIDER & MARGARETHA HÖHN

07 July 1722 St. Nicolas Church, Haguenau Marriage

Married: Nicolas Schneider son of Jean Schneider in Harthausen, to Margaretha Höhn daughter of deceased Jean Höhn and Maria Kalcklbrenner in Soufflenheim.

Godparents: Adam Harter burgher in Soufflenheim and Barbara Bucher.

Andreas Berger (infant), of Durrenbach.

Joannes Berger (father), of Durrenbach, protestant.

Barbara Heckendorn (mother), of Durrenbach, protestant.

GEORG MOSER & MARGGRETHA RÜHLIN

Beinheim, 12 May 1686 (On-Line image 54/159) Marriage Record

Georg Moser (groom), bachelor of Souffelheim (Ex Souffelheim honesti adolescens Georg Moser)
Marggretha Rühlin (bride), spinster of Leutenheimb (honesti virgine Marggretha Mosern Rühlin ex Leutenheimb)

Todd Farmerie comments: The second letter in Souffelheim is unreadable, but there is definitely a letter between the 'S' and the 'u', which given the name of the town was likely an 'o'. 'Mosern' was written then crossed out in the bride's description.

This seems straightforward, but in Leutenheim records (after what previously had been a chapel within the parish of Beinheim was upgraded to its own parish in 1704) there is only a couple named (Johann) Jacob Moser and Magdalena Ruehl/Rull, and these match Hans Jacob Mosser formerly of Soufflenheim but now of Leutenheim with wife Magdalena who sold Soufflenheim land in 1686 and 1699 (and in 1719

as 'of Soufflenheim' but his brother Paul signed on his behalf so he seems to have been absent), and he appears as Hans Jacob Mosser burgher of Littenheim, named as son of Barbara Esser in the 1699 Soufflenheim inventory of her second husband Lorentz Cron. Given that the surnames, locations and approximate chronology match a known Leutenheim couple, it looks like this marriage record has given both bride and groom the wrong names.

Complete translation: In year 1689 the 24th April was baptized in Dürrenbach Ursula legitimate daughter of Joannis Am Rein in this place, but native of Ravenspurg, and of Magdalena Itendinger his wife there, native of Soufflenheim. Godparents: Hans Michel Stephan here but native of Gunstett, and Ursula Schneider. Witnesses: Adam Werner, mayor, and Gregor Kapp, member of the council. Baptized by Pater Benedict Koler, vicar indignus.

SEBASTIAN HALTER & MARIA KUFFER

Roeschwoog 12 October 1692 Marriage Record

Maria Kuffer (bride), from Soufflenheim diocese of Strasbourg.

Joannes Sebastian Halter (groom), from Roeschwoog.

Hans Bastian (witness), signs his name.

Complete translation: In year 1692 the 12th October after the usual publications were married Joannes Sebastian Halter, in Roeschwoog, and Maria Kuffer from Soufflenheim diocese of Strasbourg in presence of undersigned witnesses: Hans Bastian (signs his name). The new married persons (both signed with an X), Second Witness (signs with an X - no name given), Lucius Franciscus vicar, signs.

Comments: Magdalena Wagner circa 1686 to 28 September 1738. In the dialect of the Palatinate and Baden, all villages that ended with “-heim” were spoken as “-em.” A writer at that time would spell a word as they heard it. So, Soufflenheim was spelled Suflem by this parish priest. (Source: Peter Distl, author of “Ortsfamilienbuch Jockgrim 1684–1909”). The bride was a resident of Jockgrim; the marriage ceremony was recorded in the church registers at Rheinzabern. The Jockgrim Catholic Church was united with the Rheinzabern parish from 1683 to 1728. Soufflenheim was owned by the Landvogtei (bailliage) of Haguenau, not the Baron of Fleckenstein. The parish priest at Rheinzabern was mistaken in this. But the district of Fleckenstein bordered the town of Soufflenheim on the east. Contributed by Michael Nuwer.

Todd Farmerie comments: The 1706 inventory of Martin Khiren refers to Adam Harter and Maria Khir being deceased, leaving Ursula and her siblings the grandparents' heirs. Adam and Maria likely died a dozen years earlier, as they disappear from transacting or witnessing contracts after 1694 and 1693 respectively.

However, this record was copied into the Surbourg Rural Chapter of Bas-Haguenau records, where it is clearly written, with Antonii Miteweg and Mariana (sic) Eva Bäyer as parents of Maria Magdalena Mitteweg, bapt. 16 April 1743. (There may be other children, I did not do a complete search, as I was primarily interested in solving the surname question.) Surbourg baptisms (image 30/105) has that of Maria Eva, daughter of Balthazaris Beyer and Anna Grody, 28 July 1710. So, the reading in the marriage should probably be 'Bayer'.

Louis Kieffer was born in Soufflenheim on 12 Aug 1813. His father was Johannes Kieffer and his mother was Catherine Messner. Louis was listed in the 1836 census as a member of his father's family. He was

identified as a soldier, but no regiment was given. To my knowledge, Louis disappeared from history after the census.

An 1844 notary document which gave Louis power of attorney for his brother's Soufflenheim property identified Louis Kieffer as a resident of Châlons-sur-Marne, France (today the town is named Châlons-en-Champagne).

The Marne Archive has his marriage record and his death record. Louis Kieffer married Anne Marie Antoinette Aubriet on 22 May 1843. The same year the rest of his family emigrated. Louis died in Châlons-sur-Marne on 2 August 1849.

One of the witnesses at Louis' 1843 marriage was Laurent Schmuck, also found in the Châlons-sur-Marne records. He was married there on 25 February 1843. Laurent was born in Soufflenheim on 9 August 1815; his father was Gabriel Schmuck; his mother was Catherine Eck. Laurent Schmuck died on 8 Feb 1865. He had the following children: Marie Rosalia: Born: 7 March 1843, Louise: Born: 8 9br 1845 (November), Francis Laurent: Born: 30 March 1848. Died: 20 7br 1849 (September), Baby boy (Garçon): Born: probably same day as death. Died: 3 8br 1849 (October), Marie Amilia: Born: 31 August 1850, and Maxine Gustave: Born: 2 October 1851.

ANDREAS MULLER

Nieuwer-Amstel, Nord-Holland 16 November 1847 Civil Death Record

Marriage Dispensations and Permissions

The following group of records does not appear to be on the site of the Archives of Alsace. It is cataloged by FamilySearch as Registres paroissiaux, 1618-1792, Proclamations de mariages (dispenses de mariage) 1618, 1721-1738 (film 1143983, Digital batch number 8321872). However, these are not from Registres paroissiaux (Parish registers) - that is how they are cataloged by FamilySearch, but the FamilySearch cataloger didn't understand what they were looking at.

From the nature of the records themselves, these are the administrative journals of the Bishop of Strasbourg. Of importance to Soufflenheim, there are records of marriage dispensations and permissions issued by the Bishop of Strasbourg for his diocese. These have been indexed for the years 1721-1738. The index may not be completely reliable and additional records from Soufflenheim might exist. The indexed names were scanned for surnames from Soufflenheim and the following records were found.

A number of records deal with consanguinity. There are different metrics for determining degrees of consanguinity, but here they are counting generations back to the common ancestor, so 3rd degree would be second cousins, sharing an ancestor 3-generations back, their great-grandparents. From other records, Hans Peter Meyer was son of Ottilia Stickelreiser, daughter of Margaretha Schaeffter, daughter of Lorents Schaeffter and Ottilia; Margaretha Schaeffter was daughter of Adam Schaeffter, son of Hans Jacob Schaeffter, son of Lorentz and Ottilia. Regarding other records, I see them for relationships as distant as '3rd and 4th' - a great-grandchild marrying of great-great-grandchild of the common ancestors, so the closest one could marry without acquiring a dispensation was 4th degree on both sides - descended from the same great-great-grandparents/3rd-cousins.

The records in 1618 were not completely searched. The first dozen pages were administrative records, not marriages or anything genealogical. Going forward about 20 pages, the records were still administrative, at which point the search ended. None of the records were indexed, indicating the entire group was not considered genealogically relevant.

For the years 1721-1738, all pages were searched by looking at the indexing panel on the right of each page to see what surnames were on the page, then looking at the individual records for any that were Soufflenheim names, or that might be mis indexed from Soufflenheim names, or that looked garbled such that they couldn't be trusted.

PROTESTANT ABJURATIONS

Eleven Lutherans and three Calvinists were baptized and converted to Catholicism at Saint Michaels in Soufflenheim from 1748-1793, often originating from elsewhere.

CHRISTOPHER BARBA AND BARBARA ENGELHART

09 February 1755 St. Michaels Soufflenheim Baptism, Series 3E472/1 Image 71

In the year 1755, on February 9, after having received sufficient instruction in the orthodox faith¹, and having abjured Luther's sect, Christopher Barba, about thirty years old, and Barbara Engelhart, about twenty-eight years old, husband and wife living in Soufflenheim, freely and publicly professed the apostolic and Roman Catholic faith, according to the formula given by our Most Holy Father Pope Pius IV. By me the undersigned, parish priest of Soufflenheim, with the authorization granted to me by my Lordship, they have been released from the bond of excommunication by which they were bound because of heresy, and have been reintegrated into the bosom of our Holy Mother Church and into the community and communion of the faithful, and participation in the sacraments. In the presence of witnesses Jean Georges Klepffel, local citizen and innkeeper ("Au Bœuf"), Laurent Sentzenbrener, local citizen and baker, and André Vögele, local provost. On my interpellation, the new converts declared they did not know how to sign; the declarants witnessed their mark and signed together with me.
