The earliest church accounts of St. Michaels in Soufflenheim, from 1678 to 1699, are found in series G6614 at the Archives of Bas-Rhin. From 1701 onwards in series G6634. Years 1679, 1681, 1687, and 1700 are missing. Year 1680 is found in the town account of that year.

Money in gulden, shilling, and denier. Twelve deniers equal one shilling, ten shillings equal one gulden. Viertel and fiertel are one quarter of a larger unit. Pfenning zins is tax, rent, interest or tribute. Recess, or resting, is money remaining from the previous year. Totals, which can be incorrect, are listed as found.
