Why upgrade your consumer unit?

If your fuse board doesn't have **RCD protection** or shows **signs of overheating**, it's very likely to be flagged during an EICR. In situations like this, replacing the unit straight away can be both **safer and more cost-effective**, as it avoids paying for testing and then replacement on the same circuits. - XOld units may overheat, with fire risk from loose or overloaded connections.
